Section 3. of the Bylaws, pursuant to §19.85(1)(e), Stats., to deliberate upon and develop strategies with regard to the bargaining of the proposed establishment/expansion of solid waste facilities pertaining to the Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility and Committee means and methods to further the Committee position, required to be confidential from Waste Management and the members of the other Affected Municipalities, in order to secure the best terms available in the public interest of the City of Franklin and its residents, and to reenter open session at the same place thereafter to act on such matters discussed therein as it deems appropriate.
