- A. Natural Resource Features Special Exception for Andrew J. Petty and Amanda E. Petty, for the purpose of erecting an aluminum fence within a 50-foot wetland setback area and installation of turf grass lawn within approximately 1,943 square feet of the wetland setback area, for property located at 12149 West Shadwell Circle, such property being zoned R-4 Suburban Single-Family Residence District (Tax Key No. 798-0142-000).
- B. Natural Resource Features Special Exception for the City of Franklin, for the purpose of allowing 754 square feet of wetland filling and paving, 4,503 square feet of filling and paving, of the wetland buffer and 4,050 square feet of wetland setback filling and paving, for properties located immediately south of and east of Pleasant View Elementary School (4601 West Marquette Avenue), and east of Pleasant View Neighborhood Park, such properties being zoned R-6 Suburban Single-Family Residence District, FW Floodway, FFO Floodplain Fringe Overlay District and C-1 Conservancy District (Tax Key Nos. 788-9978-002, 788-9977-001, 787-9999-004, 787-9998-001, 787-9997-001, 787-0046-000 and 787-0047-000), to allow for the construction of the Pleasant View/Victory Creek Trail. The estimated 4,500 foot trail begins at the sidewalk of Pleasant View Elementary School then extends south within the approximately 80-acre open field of the *Victory Creek Special Park*. A westerly stub will cross a wetland and connect to the future *Pleasant View Neighborhood Park*. The trail also proceeds east, crossing two wetland areas and then south to a tractor bridge, which crosses the east branch of the Root River.
