

## City of Franklin Project Description

The interceptor project is to serve the southern half of the City of Muskego and the southwest quarter of the City of Franklin. The project will relieve the present sewer overflows and basement backups in the City of Muskego. The project has been included in the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) planning documents since the first sewer Master Plan was developed in 1967. The project was reaffirmed in the MMSD's 1980 Master Facilities Plan and again addressed in MMSD's 2010 Facilities Plan. The advanced Facilities Plan for this current project has been completed and approved by the City of Muskego, City of Franklin, the MMSD Commission, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC), and the DNR. The project is in conformance with the SEWRPC current 208 Plan and will provide service to both the City of Muskego and the City of Franklin in conformance with each community's recently adopted Comprehensive Master Plans.

This project includes the construction of a gravity interceptor from the City of Muskego to the existing MMSD MIS at 60<sup>th</sup> and Ryan Road in the City of Franklin to eliminate SSO's in the City of Muskego per the 2005 Stipulation and Order for Judgment between the State of Wisconsin and the City of Muskego.
