Dear Mr. Shafer:


The Department of Natural Resources has completed the review of your Wastewater Facilities Plan. The Facilities Plan is hereby approved. We concur with the selected alternative that includes providing service to the northern portion of Muskego (and the southwestern portion of New Berlin connected through Muskego) via the existing Franklin-Muskego Interceptor and constructing a new Ryan Creek Interceptor to serve the southern portion of Muskego and the southwest portion of the City of Franklin.

If you believe that you have a right to challenge this decision, you should know that the Wisconsin statutes and administrative rules establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed. For judicial review of a decision pursuant to sections 227.52 and 227.53, Wis. Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to file your petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the Department. Such a petition for judicial review must name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent.


To request a contested case hearing pursuant to section 227.42, Wis. Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition for hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. All requests for contested case hearings must be made in accordance with section NR 2.05(5), Wis. Adm. Code, and served on the Secretary in accordance with section NR 2.03, Wis. Adm. Code. The filing of a request for a contested case hearing does not extend the 30 day period for filing a petition for judicial review.
