

**CITY OF FRANKLIN
SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 29, 2011
MINUTES**

- ROLL CALL I. The special meeting of the Common Council was held on August 29, 2011 and called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Mayor Taylor in the Franklin City Hall Council Chambers, 9229 W. Loomis Road, Franklin, Wisconsin. On roll call, the following were in attendance: Aldermen Olson, Solomon, Wilhelm, Taylor, Schmidt, and Skowronski. Also present were Assistant City Attorney Sajdak and City Clerk Wesolowski.
- CITIZEN COMMENT II. Citizen comment period was opened at 5:20 p.m. and closed at 5:20 p.m.
- REVOCAION OF OPERATOR'S LICENSE, M. KROLIKOWSKI III.A. Alderman Solomon moved to adopt the License Committee Report, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation as to Action, and deny the renewal of a 2011-2012 operator's license to Mark A. Krolikowski and to revoke the same effective immediately. Seconded by Alderman Taylor. All voted Aye; motion carried.
- REVOCAION OF TRANSIENT MERCHANT LICENSE, D. KOEHLER, JR. III.B. Alderman Solomon moved to adopt the License Committee Report, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation as to Action, and revoke the Transient Merchant license of Dennis E. Koehler, Jr., effective immediately. Seconded by Alderman Taylor. All voted Aye; motion carried.
- It was further moved by Alderman Solomon to deny the Temporary Entertainment and Amusement license application of Dennis E. Koehler, Jr. Seconded by Alderman Taylor. All voted Aye; motion carried.
- TEMPORARY ENTERTAINMENT, VFW III.C. Upon recommendation of the License Committee, Alderman Solomon moved to approve the Temporary Entertainment and Amusement license for the VFW #10394, person in charge: Russ Owens, for St. Martins Fair on September 4 and 5, 2011, subject to notification by the City Clerk of the hours for music. Seconded by Alderman Schmidt. All voted Aye; motion carried.
