Alderman Olson moved to override the Mayor's veto of the action of the City of Franklin Common Council on December 5, 2006, passing a motion to reconsider Ordinance No. 2006-1895, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS RELATING TO RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS FOR SEX OFFENDERS AND DIRECTING ACTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF FOR VIOLATION THEREOF. Seconded by Alderman Solomon. On Roll Call, all voted No. Motion failed.
