- PEDESTRIAN CROSSING OF S 51ST STREET AT HIGHLAND DRIVE (TO HIGH SCHOOL IN A.M.)
Motion made by Alderman Schmidt, seconded by Commissioner Bartnicki to refer to staff to review and interact with school district on a design solution for pedestrian crossing of S. 51st Street at Highland Drive and second to contact police for enforcement of 15 mph speed limit in school zone during school time. Motion carried.
- CONCERN FOR SNOW PLOWING AT 11424 W BALBOA STREET
Superintendent Schaefer to evaluate plowing strategies including plow direction and winging snow bank back to create storage.
- DEPOSITING OF SNOW ON/ACROSS CITY STREETS
Informational. Superintendent Schaefer to implement 2009 council action as a procedure for informing residents about snow plowing and work with police in implementation.
