## City of Franklin Community Development Authority Meeting Minutes July 18, 2013

### I. Call to Order and Roll Call

Member Ryan moved and Member Mullarkey seconded a motion to recommend approval of the certified survey map application of MLG Development, Inc., for the property located at approximately 4701 to 5099 West Oakwood Park Drive. Upon voice vote, all voted "aye". Motion carried: 5-0.

B. City of Franklin "70/30" residential/commercial tax base ratio goal definition and calculations.

(This item was taken first in order at the meeting.) Mayor Taylor presented the item and its history through current. The members engaged in detailed discussion, including the impacts of new development City-wide and within the separate School District areas, the state of the economy and the relevance of property assessments in the "70/30" goal calculations, and the import of setting goals. Member Mullarkey moved and Member Holpfer seconded a motion to recommend maintaining the "70/30" goal for the entire City of Franklin and that a report back to the Community Development Authority should be made by staff when new property assessments are available following revaluations in regard to their impact upon the goal ratio. Upon voice vote, all voted "aye". Motion carried: 5-0.
