MINUTES

- I. The March 5, 2014 Police & Fire Commission Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Commission President Donohoo in the Hearing Room at Franklin City Hall. Members present were Commissioners Donohoo, Maher-Johnson, Sass and Nelson. Commissioner Lindner was excused.
- II. Hiring of Police Patrol Officers - The Police and Fire Commission may enter closed session pursuant to §19.85 (1)(c) Stats, to consider employment of Police Patrol Officer candidates. Specific items to be discussed include the interviewing of numerous applicants and determining which applicants will be passed on for further consideration in the hiring process. The Commission may reconvene into open session at the same place thereafter to act on such matters discussed in the closed session as it deems appropriate and to continue the meeting agenda.

Upon roll call vote the Commission went into closed session at 6:02 p.m. The Commission reconvened into open session at 6:30 p.m. Motion by Commissioner Sass and seconded by Commissioner Maher-Johnson that both candidates interviewed tonight are passed on in the process for further consideration.
