HELD IN THE COMMON COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT CITY HALL  
September 12, 2006

CALL TO ORDER Chairman Young called the Board of Public Works meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 12, 2006, held in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

ROLL CALL AND PLEDGE TO FLAG Present: Alderman Kosovich and Commissioners Rogowski, Wolff, Bischke and Webster. Also present Assistant City Engineer Romeis, Hwy. Superintendent Schaefer and Alderman Hammelman. Excused was Commissioner Clavette. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF AUGUST 8, 2006 Motion made by Commissioner Wolff, seconded by Commissioner Rogowski to approve the minutes of August 8, 2006. Commissioner Bischke abstained. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT Comments by Allen Hammelman on Items A and D under Old Business. Comments by Mike Fassbender, Brian Stelloh, Diane Maegli-Hippert, Tim Wilimitis, Al Liska, and Kevin Cech on Item A regarding extension of Marquette Ave. and S. Hillendale Drive to connection.

OLD BUSINESS

EXTENSION OF MARQUETTE AVENUE AND S. HILLENDALE DRIVE TO CONNECTION Motion made by Commissioner Rogowski, seconded by Commissioner Wolff to direct City staff to contact property owner and pursue possible acquisition of land for extension of Marquette Avenue to 49<sup>th</sup> Street. Direct City staff to prepare estimate for temporary road for emergency access from Hillendale to Marquette Avenue. Motion carried.

SNOWMOBILE BRIDGE W. OAKWOOD ROAD Motion made by Commissioner Webster, seconded by Commissioner Wolff to direct City staff to remove snowmobile bridge on W. Oakwood Road on or after September 25, 2006 and bill property owner for removal and disposal of the bridge. Motion carried.

REVIEW TRUCK CHASSIS FOR NEW SWEEPER Motion made by Commissioner Rogowski, seconded by Commissioner Webster to recommend to purchase (1) M2-106 dual steering wheel truck from Truck Country of WI for \$55,919. Chairman Young recused himself for this item. Motion carried.

Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Wolff, seconded by Commissioner Bischke to recommend to Common Council with Board of Public Works approval for temporary "NO PARKING" signs by police order, on mail box side of street, and one hour parking on the opposite side of street. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Wolff, seconded by Alderman Kosovich to table item. Motion carried.

STOP BARS ON S. 27<sup>TH</sup> STREET AT RIVERWOOD BOULEVARD

Motion made by Chairman Young, seconded by Commissioner Rogowski to direct City staff to contact Lowe's and request their painting of stop bars on 27<sup>th</sup> Street at Riverwood Boulevard. Motion carried.

SPEED LIMIT ON S. 60<sup>TH</sup> STREET, W. OAKWOOD ROAD TO SOUTH COUNTY LINE ROAD

Motion made by Alderman Kosovich, seconded by Commissioner Rogowski to direct City staff to gather speed and traffic counts and report back at October 2006 City of Franklin BPW meeting. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

ADOPT THE PROPOSED LAND DESCRIPTION IN THE REVISED RIGHT-OF-WAY PLAT AND THE REVISED RIGHT-OF-WAY PLAT ITSELF, FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF W. OAKWOOD RD. FROM S. 27<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO A PT. APPROX. ½ MILE WEST OF S. 27<sup>TH</sup> STREET, AS IF THE DESCRIPTION AND PLAT WERE MADE BY THE BOARD AND TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL THEREOF TO THE COMMON COUNCIL

Motion made by Commissioner Rogowski, seconded by Commissioner Wolff to recommend to Common Council with Board of Public Works approval, adopt the proposed land description in the revised right-of-way plat and the revised right-of-way plat itself, for the reconstruction of W. Oakwood Rd. from S. 27<sup>th</sup> Street to a point approximately ½ mile west of S. 27<sup>th</sup> Street, as if the description and plat were made by the Board and to recommend approval thereof to the Common Council. The vote was three ayes and two voted no. Motion carried.
