- When alcohol is used, poor decisions are made beyond driving under the influence.
- Homeowner's insurance may be cancelled if underage drinking problems occur on the property.

- Remember that it is illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
- Reinforce the message that no one should allow someone who has been drinking to drive them anywhere.
