## SAVE THE DATE! - November 12, 2016 "CHEERS TO EDUCATION" GALA


Mark your calendars and bring your friends out for a great event!

The Franklin Educational Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization dedicated to enhancing educational opportunities for Franklin students through business and community partnerships. Since 1996, the Foundation has raised over \$1.2 million for educational-based grants that allow teachers to enrich and enhance education in Franklin public schools. The governing Board of Directors consists of a diverse range of community leaders, teachers, parents and professionals who partner with school district professionals and teachers to improve the educational experience for Franklin students.

Over the past 20 years, the Foundation has been able to fund grants to FPS teachers who are using cutting edge technologies and materials to engage their students in innovative ways. Forest Park Middle School teacher Sherrie Nackel received a foundation grant to purchase SMART Boards for her classroom in 2006. Mrs. Nackel shared, "I love modeling problems for students on the SMART Board during my math mini lessons. Being able to share different solutions for problems teaches students that there are multiple ways to solve problems and students are able to share their thinking with each other. Students are very engaged while learning challenging math concepts in a fun and interactive manner thanks to our SMART Board."

Some other great projects funded by the Foundation include a mobile environmental classroom for the high school, the purchase of 3-D printers for Forest Park Middle School, and LEGO STEM materials for Country Dale Elementary School. An upgrade of the high school T.V. Technology Lab was made possible through Foundation grants over three phases.

These are just a few examples of what the Franklin Educational Foundation has been able to provide. None of this great work is possible without the ongoing support of the community. On behalf of the teachers and students of FPS, we are grateful for our generous partners and donors!
