NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE PLAN COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN will conduct a public hearing on Thursday, June 5, 2014, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers at the Franklin City Hall, 9229 West Loomis Road, Franklin, Wisconsin 53132, to hear public comment regarding an application from the City of Franklin for a Special Exception to Natural Resource Feature Provisions, for properties located at and about 7501 South 49th Street, zoned R-6 Suburban Single-Family Residence District, C-1 Conservancy District, FC Floodplain Conservancy District, FW Floodway District and P-1 Park District, which bear Tax Key Nos. 788-9981-002 and 788-9999-003. The requested Special Exception to Natural Resource Feature Provisions is for the purpose of allowing approximately 1,500 square feet of wetland filling and paving, 7,100 square feet of filling and paving of the wetland buffer and 11,100 square feet of wetland setback filling and paving for the proposed extension of West Evergreen Street to accommodate access to Pleasant View Neighborhood Park. This public hearing is being held pursuant to the requirements of Section 15-9.0110 Applications for a Special Exception to Natural Resource Feature Provisions, and Section 15-10.0208 Special Exceptions to Natural Resource Feature Provisions, of the City of Franklin Unified Development Ordinance. The public is invited to attend the public hearing and to provide input.
