Greetings from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is well underway with the reconstruction of WIS 241 (S. 27th Street), from south of W. Drexel Avenue to north of W. College Avenue.

Crews have scheduled concrete paving and saw-cutting operations to start Monday, October 5, as part of the reconstruction project.

Concrete pavement operations will take place during the normal work day. However, for expansion purposes, the concrete needs to be saw-cut which also takes place during the nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses will experience noise impacts periodically throughout these operations.
