S. 27th Street (Milwaukee County) Project Information

About The Project

The project stretches approximately 2.3 miles from south of W. Drexel Ave. to north of W. College Ave., in the cities of Franklin and Oak Creek in Milwaukee County.

Construction began in spring 2015 and is scheduled to be completed in fall 2016.



The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is well underway with the reconstruction of WIS 241 (S. 27th Street), from south of W. Drexel Avenue to north of W. College Avenue.

As part of the reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project:


North segment traffic switch on S. 27th Street scheduled for mid-July.

- WIS 241 northbound traffic between Minnesota and College avenues are scheduled to be shifted to the existing southbound lanes until late fall, while crews construct the WIS 241 northbound lanes. (See map for details)
- Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction between just north of College Avenue to Minnesota Avenue.
- One lane of traffic will be maintained between Villa Drive to Minnesota Avenue.
