S. 27th Street (Milwaukee County) Project Information

About The Project

The project stretches approximately 2.3 miles from south of W. Drexel Ave. to north of W. College Ave., in the cities of Franklin and Oak Creek in Milwaukee County.

Construction began in spring 2015 and is scheduled to be completed late fall 2016.



As part of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's WIS 241 (S. 27th Street) reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project.

Upcoming Rawson Avenue Short-Term Closures:

Crews are preparing to complete paving operations at the Rawson Avenue intersection and will require a few left-turn short-term closures.


The project work is scheduled to begin at 6 a.m. Friday, September 16 and remain closed through late September.

- The left turn from southbound S. 27th Street to eastbound Rawson Avenue will be closed short-term.
- The left turn from northbound S. 27th Street to westbound Rawson Avenue will be closed short-term.
- The left turn from eastbound Rawson Avenue to northbound S. 27th Street will be closed short-term.

→ Travelers are encouraged to find an alternate route to get around the closures.

All turning movements at College and Drexel avenues will remain open during the Rawson Avenue short-term closures.

All upcoming work and closures are weather dependent and subject to change.
