 - 3. **CASE NO. 2024-17: SWEET. Minor Variance** request from Section 15-3.0801 of the Unified Development Ordinance to allow for a 58 square foot outdoor spa in a corner side yard with a 20-foot side yard setback when the Unified Development Ordinance does not allow for accessory structures within the corner side yard. For property located at 7917 S. 47th St. (807 0001 000), Aldermanic District 5.
