- I. The meeting of the Tourism Commission was called to order by Chair Schermetzler at 6:01 p.m.
- II. The floor was opened for citizen comment at 6:02 p.m. and closed at 6:03 p.m. There were no public comments.

- IV. Schermetzler moved, supported by Wylie, to request from the Mayor and Common Council that a new member position be created for the Tourism Commission. Motion carried.
- V. Schermetzler moved, supported by Adamski, to have the Tourism Commission Secretary also serve as the Treasurer of the Commission. Motion carried.

Schermetzler moved, supported by Wylie, to adopt a 50-50 matching grant program in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Tourism Co-op Program with a maximum grant limit per business of \$2,000/annually and an overall budget of \$20,000 annually. Motion carried. Staff to work on brochure and reimbursement form for Tourism Commission review.
- IX. Schermetzler moved, supported by Wylie, to instruct staff to move forward with CGI Video company on an online video project for the City. Motion carried.
