



# CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN FRANKLIN/OAK CREEK SEWER EXTENSION PROJECT

## CONSTRUCTION OF THE MMSD SEWER EXTENSION PROJECT WILL BEGIN THIS MONTH.

The goals of the project are twofold:

- Extend the sanitary sewer service in both Oak Creek and Franklin.
- Lay the foundation for future expansion of sanitary sewer service in the Village of Raymond and the Village of Caledonia in Racine County.

The project was initiated at the request from the City of Oak Creek, City of Franklin, Village of Raymond, and the Village of Caledonia in 2014.

There will be impacts to traffic during construction. Major impacts will be at the following intersections:

1. **Spring 2026** — near the intersection of S. 27<sup>th</sup> Street and Oakwood Road.
2. **Summer 2026** — at W. Elm Road and S. 27<sup>th</sup> Street.
3. **Late summer** — at W. County Line Road and S. 27<sup>th</sup> Street.

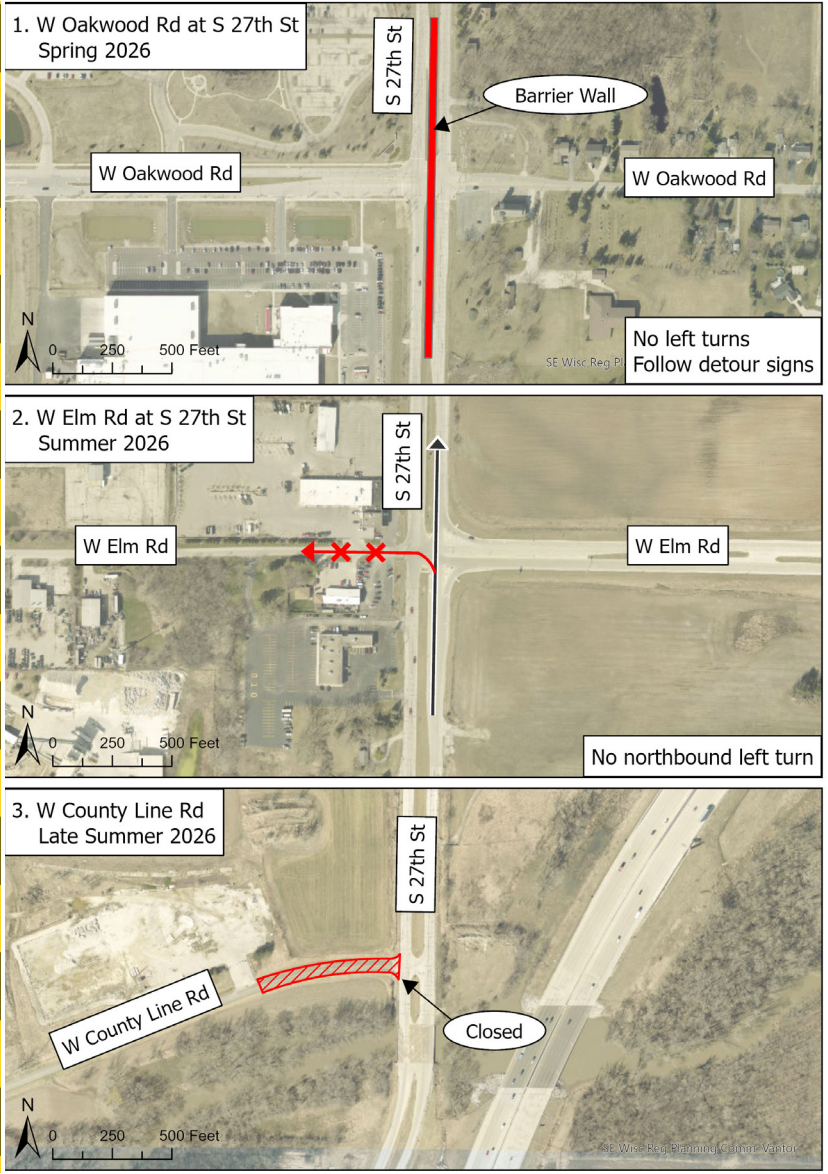
