

Private Property Infiltration and Inflow Reduction Program Property Owner Waiver Form to Inspect

By checking the first box and signing below, you are confirming that you are indeed the property owner and agree to allow the City and its contractor(s) onto your property to conduct investigations. You may opt out of this program at any time by notifying me in writing (or email) at my address below.

In exchange for your participation, the City's Private Property Infiltration and Inflow (PPII) Reduction program will pay for 100% of the investigation. Waiver forms must be postmarked or emailed by **October 5, 2020.**

STEP 1: Indicate your preference to participate or not to participate in the investigation.

L (we) choose to participate in the PPII Program and agree with the following:

- 1. I confirm that I am the property owner.
- 2. I agree to allow the City and its contractor(s) onto my property to conduct an exterior and interior investigation of my property and understand that the PPII Program will cover 100% of the investigation cost.
- 3. I authorize the City and its contractor(s) to take photographs and video of the exterior of my property and interior basement features that are associated with the storm and sanitary sewer systems, including sump pumps, basement drains, basement sinks, and relevant piping.
- 4. I understand that there is a possibility that the investigation will identify an issue on my property for which I will be responsible to correct using a contractor of my choosing. If any issues are found, the City will work with me to fix the issue and will not require immediate correction.

I (we) shall hold harmless the City, its employees, representatives, contractors, agents and assigns from liability arising out of the City conducting investigations as set forth above.
