OVERVIEW

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation Southeast Region (WisDOT) is providing a project update for the S. 76th Street project in Milwaukee County. The painting over Loomis Road is nearly complete and bridge work on S. 76th Street is progressing as scheduled.



SCOPE OF WORK

This project will consist of bridge rehabilitation, bridge painting, concrete pavement and approaches, curb and gutter, pavement markings, and signal work.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Loomis Road (State Highway 36) will continue to see single lane closures in each direction to facilitate bridge construction operations. Impacts on S. 76th Street (County Highway U) will include a reduction to one lane in each direction for inside lane deck overlay operations and Stage 2 outside lane work.

SCHEDULE

Painting operations below the 76th Street Bridge are nearly complete, with touch-up work needed as bridge construction progresses. 76th Street bridge and roadway work are ongoing with work in the work zone set to switch from Stage 1 (inside lanes) to Stage 2 (outside lanes) on October 7.


UPCOMING OPEN HOUSE
