


Public Meeting #1 | October 28, 2025

The W. Puetz Road Pathway Project will design a new off-road shared-use path (trail) between S. 76th Street (County U) and W. St Martins Road (WIS 100). The trail will safely accommodate people walking, biking, and rolling, while providing separation from motor vehicle traffic.

The project will connect neighborhoods, businesses, and community spaces, creating new opportunities for recreation and active transportation.

Project Timeline





The trail will provide a dedicated space for people walking and biking. By separating users from motor traffic, the project will create a safer environment for all ages and abilities.



The new trail will link neighborhoods to parks, businesses, community destinations, and other shareduse paths, and promote active transportation.



Create space for walking and biking encourages active lifestyles to support the physical and mental health of our community.



The trail will provide additional recreation opportunities to nearby residents. Residents can connect with each other and enjoy the experience of moving through their neighborhoods and city.
