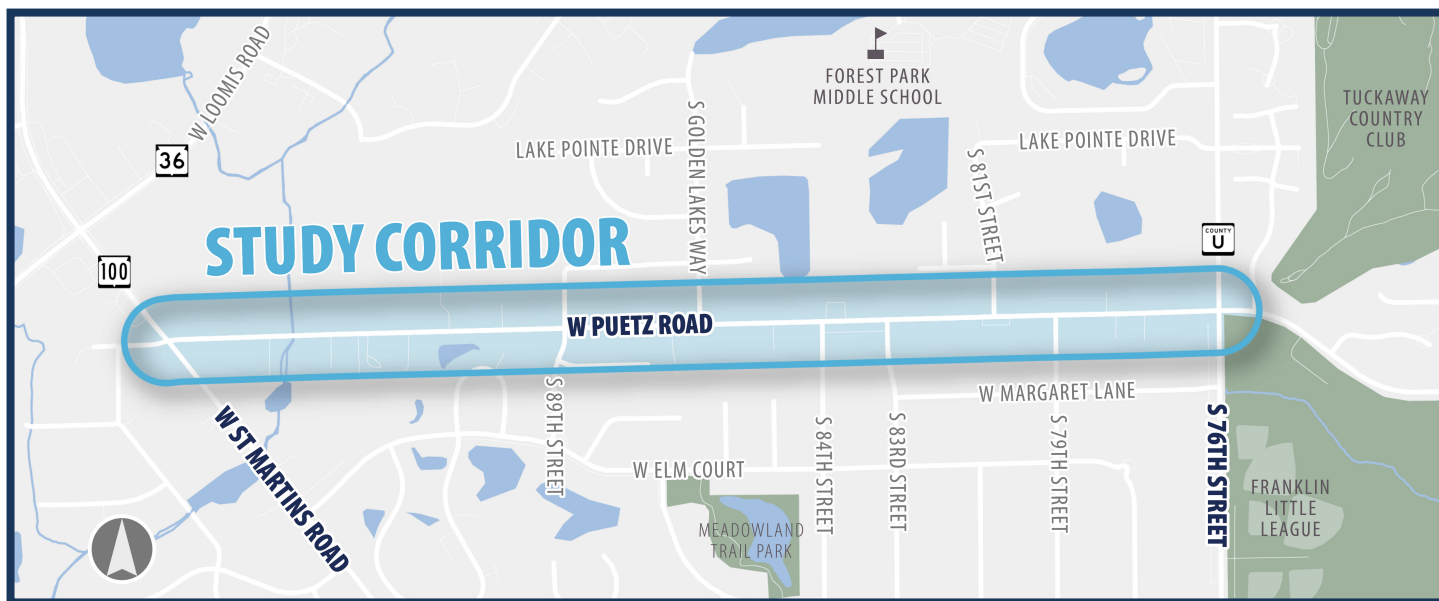
The W. Puetz Road Pathway Project will enhance recreational opportunities by connecting community spaces, businesses, and residents.
