



PROJECT UPDATE

Traffic Switch

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing approximately 3 miles of WIS 100 between South 60th Street and West St. Martins Road. The following work is scheduled as part of this project.

Beginning Friday, July 18, 2025:

WIS 36 (Loomis Road) traffic is scheduled to shift to the newly constructed outside driving lanes at the WIS 100 intersection as crews begin reconstructing the inside lanes.

- Through traffic remains open in all directions
- Left- and right-turn movement remains open in all directions

Following the traffic switch, crews are expected to begin pavement saw-cutting and removal operations.

Businesses and residents should be aware that noise and dust will be associated with this work. Steps are taken to minimize these effects.

WIS 100 remains closed between 60th Street and Puetz Road.

Motorists with destinations within the work zone are encouraged to use the nearest available side street to access WIS 100.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.



All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
