Independence Day Parade Detour

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing WIS 100 from S. 60th Street to W. St. Martins Road in the City of Franklin, Milwaukee County. Work is scheduled to be completed in fall 2025.

Friday, July 4 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.:

 WIS 36 (Loomis Road) is scheduled to close between 76th Street and WIS 100 for the City of Franklin's Independence Day celebration.

Note: WIS 100 between 60th Street and Puetz Road remains closed long-term to non-local traffic.

Detour:

- → Motorists traveling on WIS 100 are encouraged to use WIS 241 (27th Street) and County BB (Rawson Avenue) to get around the WIS 100 closure.
- → Motorists traveling on WIS 36 are encouraged to use WIS 100 and County BB to get around the closure.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
