Children's Parade 10:30 am

Kids do not need to register. The morning begins with Geno's kid show for the kids from 9:45 till the children's parade begins. Arrive no later than 10 am. No gas-powered or motorized vehicles allowed in parade.

Arrive at the Police Department parking lot by 10 am.

Drop offs allowed for kids **and at least one adult** at the front parking lot of the Police station, 9455 W. Loomis Road. Vehicles will not be able to park in any area of the Police Department parking lot. The children's parade is an annual tradition where the kids decorate their bikes, wagons, and strollers in patriotic red, white, and blue colors.



Main Parade 11 am

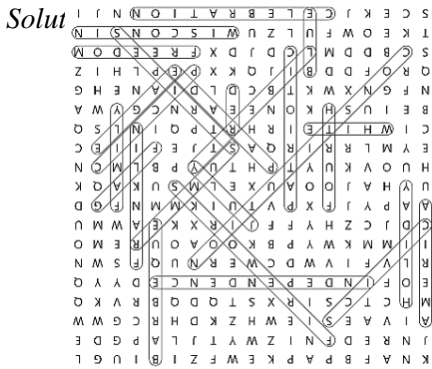

Parade route starts at W. Loomis Road and Forest Hill Avenue, progresses north on Loomis Road to Drexel Avenue, proceeds east down Drexel Avenue to the Fire Station. Water guns and water balloons prohibited. **Bleachers will NOT be provided.** No parking is allowed on either side of Loomis Road on July 3rd and 4th and violators will be ticketed and towed by the Franklin Police Department.
