IMPORTANT NOTICE: A SNOW EMERGENCY IS IN EFFECT FOR THE CITY OF FRANKLIN UNTIL 6 PM ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 13, 2024, RESULTING IN CLOSURES OF MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS

Dear Residents and City Staff,

I have declared a snow emergency for the City of Franklin to be in effect until 6 p.m. on Saturday, January 13, 2024.

The Chief of Police or any police officer within the Police Department may remove any vehicle from the street that interferes with snow removal equipment during a snow emergency. The removal cost shall be paid by the vehicle owner parked in violation of this section.

Due to inclement weather, the Franklin Public Library is closed today, Friday, January 12, 2024.

City Hall will close early today, January 12th, at noon. This decision prioritizes the safety of our dedicated staff during their commute.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Stay safe. City Hall will resume regular operating hours of 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday, January 15, 2024.
