ORDINANCE NO. 2026-2727

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2025-2712, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2026 ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE POLICE GRANTS FUND TO PROVIDE \$240,330 OF GRANT RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE COMMUNITY POLICING DEVELOPMENT: SUPPORTING AGENCIES SEEKING ACCREDITATION GRANT

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Franklin adopted the 2026 Annual Budgets for the City of Franklin on November 11, 2025; and

WHEREAS, on October 21, 2025, the Common Council approved participation in and acceptance of the Community Policing Development: Supporting Agencies Seeking Accreditation Grant through the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to support the Police Department's pursuit of professional accreditation in order to enhance officer safety, reduce liability risks, and provide a foundation for operational excellence and best practices in law enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides funding over a two-year period to support costs associated with achieving and maintaining accreditation through WILEAG; and

WHEREAS, due to the timing of the grant approval, the associated grant revenues and expenditures were not included in the adopted 2026 Budget; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is required to recognize the grant funding and appropriate the associated expenditures within the 2026 Budget in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Franklin does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1 That the 2026 Budget for the Police Grants Fund be amended as follows:

Police Grants Fund

Revenues	Grant Revenue	Increase	\$240,330
Personnel	Personnel Services	Increase	\$166,306
Capital	Equipment	Increase	\$74,024

Section 2 Pursuant to §65.90(5)(ar), Wis. Stats., the City Clerk is directed to post a notice of this budget amendment within fifteen days of adoption of this Ordinance on the City's website.



Section 4 All ordinances and parts of ordinances in contravention to this ordinance are hereby repealed.


