ORDINANCE NO. 2026-2748

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2025-2712, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING
THE 2026 ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL FUND TO TRANSFER \$19,500 OF
CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY TO
CLAIM THE FEDERAL SOLAR INVESTMENT TAX CREDITS

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Franklin adopted the 2026 Annual Budgets for the City of Franklin on November 11, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin has contracted with Johnson Controls for the installation of solar panels at the City Library and Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the solar photovoltaic systems makes the City eligible to pursue federal solar investment tax credits available under the Inflation Reduction Act and applicable federal provisions; and

WHEREAS, the city is required to complete and submit the necessary federal filings and supporting documentation within the applicable filing timeframe, including the November 15, 2026 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the city has engaged CliftonLarsonAllen LLP ("CLA"), the City's independent auditors, to perform the professional services necessary to assist the city in properly calculating and claiming the applicable federal solar investment tax credits; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the professional services is \$19,500; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the General Fund contingency account to fund this unanticipated expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that amending the 2026 General Fund budget to provide funding for these professional services is in the best interest of the City and will allow the City to pursue federal solar investment tax credits associated with the City's solar installations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Franklin does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1 That the 2026 Budget for the General Fund be amended as follows:

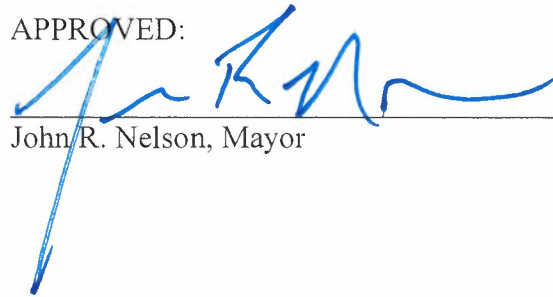

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- Section 2 Pursuant to §65.90(5)(ar), Wis. Stats., the City Clerk is directed to post a notice of this budget amendment within fifteen days of adoption of this Ordinance on the City's website.
- Section 3 The terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable. Should any term or provision of this ordinance be found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining terms and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4 All ordinances and parts of ordinances in contravention to this ordinance are hereby repealed.
