


CITY OF FRANKLIN

The accompanying tax bill represents the total taxes levied by the various taxing jurisdictions and collected by the City of Franklin. The following information illustrates the distribution of taxes on behalf of those jurisdictions.

The City of Franklin general operations represents roughly one quarter of the total property tax bill.



The 2024 general property tax levy is used to fund government operations in the 2025 Budget. The City of Franklin continues to experience some of the lowest tax rates in Milwaukee County. Franklin's property tax levy which covers total City spending has grown very slowly over the last 10 years compared to most other taxing authorities.
