Stay home as much as possible and limit trips to the essentials like buying groceries or getting tested if you need to. Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds as frequently as possible or using hand sanitizer. Cover coughs or sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow, not hands). Know the symptoms of COVID-19 and get tested if you have any symptoms of illness. Get vaccinated when you are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine.
