BUILDINGS AND HVAC COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

Failure to submit this form may result in penalties as specified in SPS 361.23 and/or local ordinances. This form must be submitted prior to the plan approval expiration date or another submittal may be required.

General Instructions: Prior to the initial occupancy of new buildings or additions and the final occupancy of altered existing buildings, submit this completed and signed form to the municipal building inspection office (refer to the plan approval letter for agency address), and Division of Industry Services. (If the review was done by the municipality, the compliance statement goes only to the municipal building inspector and a copy is not needed for Division of Industry Services.)
