## **Converting from Well to City Water**

## **Homeowners/Contractors**:

- Contact Water Department, 414-421-2613, to see if water is available.
- Have properly licensed contractor apply for a Plumbing Permit through Inspection Services.
- Contact Engineering, 414-425-7510, for possible Right of Way Permits
- Pay the Water Impact Fee (Varies yearly). Call Inspections, 414-425-0084, for fee.
- If keeping the Well you will need a Well Operating Permit. This must be renewed every 5 years. Well can ONLY be used for the exterior hose bibbs.
   A safe water sample will be required at time of application and for each 5year renewal.
- If abandoning the Well, a Well Abandonment Permit is required. Contact a
  Pump or Well installer.
- Once approved Plumbing Inspector will order the water meter.

## **Contractors:**

- All flared curb stops must be replaced with a compression curb stop, water department will provide all materials, contractor will perform the work.
   Contact Water department 48 hours in advance of starting work.
- New connections at main will be inspected by Sewer and Water Dept.
- Plumbing Inspector will inspect from curb stop into house.

## Plumbing permit requirements:

- New connection to Public Main (If no curb stop at property line)
- Total footage main or curb stop to house
- Replacement of or altering of building water piping
- Water calcs
- Street Cut (If having to cut into road)
