CITIZEN COMMENT PERIOD AND CORRESPONDENCE:	Citizen comment period was opened at 5:16 p.m. and closed at 5:17 p.m.
MINUTES APPROVED:	Commissioner Schubilske moved to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2023, regular meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Peterson. All voted Aye; motion carried.
VOUCHER LIST:	Commissioner Peterson moved to approve the Vouchers for October, 2023, in the amount of \$31,331.81. Seconded by Commissioner Takerian. All voted Aye; motion carried.
REPORT ON WATER SYSTEM PERFORMANCE: DISTRIBUTION & COLLECTION/ ADMINISTRATIVE OPERATIONS UPDATE:	Superintendent Roberts informed Board that the Utility is preparing for winter operations. A fire hydrant was hit at 27 th St. and Ryan Rd. by hit & run driver. On October 4 th , there was a water main break at the Aurora Healthcare Facility on Loomis Rd., across from City Hall. Repair and restoration costs will be invoiced to Aurora. On October 9 th , a water lateral leak was repaired on River Meadows Ct. Meter change out program has come to a halt due to lack of meters. Meter reading was completed and 3 rd quarter bills sent out.
	Glen Morrow informed Board that a water survey was sent out to the Hale Park neighborhood (northwest corner of City) – 279 surveys sent out. Results will be brought to Common Council in November.
