CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:

REPORT ON WATER SYSTEM PERFORMANCE:

DISTRIBUTION & COLLECTION/ ADMINISTRATIVE OPERATIONS UPDATE: Superintendent Beardsley reported that on March 31st there was a water main break at Drexel Avenue and 66th Street, estimating about 200,000 gallons lost. Highway 100 work has started. Employee resigned last week, leaving department with 2 openings. He will invite Mike Sullivan, Oak Creek Water & Sewer Utility General Manager, to the May meeting to update Commission on Oak Creek's plant expansion project.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

LOVERS LANE WATER TOWER & WATER MAIN PROJECT UPDATE:

Superintendent Beardsley reported Vinton started on Contract C and should be done next week. Contract B is at a standstill until weather permits. Also waiting on change order.

DPW CAMPUS UTILITIES:

Superintendent Beardsley informed Board the water main is all in service. Landscaping is done and asphalt restoration being completed this week. Utility is complete with this project.

WATER MAIN ALONG W. ST. MARTINS ROAD FROM W. PUETZ ROAD TO W. ELM COURT: Superintendent Beardsley informed Board everything is installed and in service.
