1. **HEARING NO. 2019-01 Variance Application**John M. Psuik

7330 S. 46th Street

Member Knackert moved and Member Adams seconded a motion to approve a variance of the Unified Development Ordinance to exceed the maximum square footage limit for wood-framed accessory structures. The application requests a variance from Section 15-3.0801C.2. of the Unified Development Ordinance to exceed the maximum square footage limit for wood-framed accessory structures (i.e., 900 square feet) to construct a 28' x 36' accessory structure totaling 1,008 square feet, and Table 15-3.0203 of the Unified Development Ordinance to have a side yard on a corner lot setback of 30 feet, opposed to the R-3 Suburban/Estate Single-Family Residence District minimum side yard on a corner lot setback of 35 feet for property located at 7330 S. 46th Street. Upon voice vote, all voted 'aye'. Motion carried (4-0-2). The variance was approved.
