- A. Commissioner Dorsan moved and Commissioner Nickerson seconded a motion to allow the use of the Lions Pavilion for the sale of Cousins Subs during the Summer Concert Series in Lions Legend Park. All voted 'aye', motion carried.
- B. Commissioner Dorsan presented the report from the Friends of Franklin Parks and updated the progress of the birdhouses to be installed at area parks. No action needed, none taken.
- C. No report was available from the Franklin Trails Committee for review. No action needed, none taken.
- D. Superintendent Schaefer presented the Parks maintenance report.

- A. Greg Kowalski and Michael Soto of Citizens for Community Development presented plans for a conceptual multi-recreational sports facility on Milwaukee County land in the Root River Parkway at the southwest corner of South 51st Street and West Puetz Road. Alderman Solomon moved and Commissioner Bartoszek seconded a motion to request the Common Council to enter into negotiations with Milwaukee County for the lease of land at the southwest corner of South 51st Street and West Puetz Road for development of a multi-recreational sports facility. All voted 'aye', motion carried.
