**MINUTES**

- I. The March 6, 2013 Police & Fire Commission Meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by Commission President Donohoo in the Community Room at the Franklin Law Enforcement Center. (It was announced in the lobby of the police station that the PFC meeting was starting in open session in case anyone wanted to come into the Community Room.)

Members present were Commissioners Donohoo, Lindner, Nelson, and Sass. Commissioner Maher-Johnson was excused.

- II. Hiring of Police Patrol Officers - The Police and Fire Commission may enter closed session pursuant to §19.85 (1)(c) Stats, to consider employment of Police Patrol Officer candidates. Specific items to be discussed include the interviewing of numerous applicants and determining which applicants will be passed on for further consideration in the hiring process. The Commission may reconvene into open session at the same place thereafter to act on such matters discussed in the closed session as it deems appropriate and to continue the meeting agenda.

Motion by Commissioner Sass and seconded by Commissioner Lindner to go into closed session at 6:07 p.m. Motion Carried: Ayes – All.

The Commission re-entered open session at 8:15 p.m. upon unanimous vote. Commission President Donohoo explained they had interviewed 12 candidates while in closed session.

Motion by Commissioner Sass and seconded by Commissioner Lindner that applicants 1, 2, 11 and 12 are passed on for further consideration. Applicants 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 are not passed on. Motion Carried: Ayes – All.
