All voted 'aye', motion carried.

B. Planner Fuchs read the Official Notice of Public Hearing for Special Use request of Steven G. Rekowski, Pieper Electric Inc. the record. The Public Hearing was opened at 7:36 p.m. and closed at 7:36 p.m.

Commissioner Fowler moved and Alderman Skowronski seconded a motion to recommend approval of a resolution imposing conditions and restrictions for the approval of a Special Use for an electrical contracting business use upon property located at 11320 West Forest Home Avenue, contingent upon providing a revised Site Plan and Landscape Plan as stated in Condition 5. All voted 'aye', motion carried.
