OFFICIAL NOTICE TO CUT  
OR DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Section 66.0407, Wisconsin Statutes, that each and every person who owns, occupies, or controls land in the City of Franklin shall destroy noxious weeds by cutting so as to effectively prevent plants from maturing to the bloom or flower stage.

Noxious weeds include, but are not limited to, creeping jenny, field bindweed and Canada thistle and other rank growth or vegetation. All noxious weeds shall be kept cut to a height not to exceed 18", and in platted subdivisions which have buildings on more than 50% of the lots, noxious weeds shall be kept cut to a height of not to exceed 6".

Failure to comply with above provisions shall cause the performing of such requirements by the weed commissioner and will result in costs being charged against such land on the next tax roll as provided for by State Law.
