04/11/2022

Mutual Aid – Greenfield PD S 27th St/W Upham Dr

On Monday, 04/11/22, Greenfield PD requested a K-9 walkaround on a traffic stop.

Fraud 8800 Blk W Travis Ln

On Monday, 04/11/22, a victim reported unknown actor(s) hacked his phone and transferred his crypto coin base account in the amount of \$3,000.00 and \$1,000.00 from his banks checking account.

Theft/Destruction of Property 9900 Blk S Franklin Dr

On Monday, 04/11/22, several victims discovered the windows of their vehicles had been smashed and items inside their cars had been stolen. This occurred while they were working at various locations in the business park.

On Monday, 04/11/22, FRPD Detectives were assigned to investigate a possible election law violation alleged to have occurred during the previous week's local elections.

On Monday, 04/11/22, a resident of Franklin reported that her son took her 2013 Nissan Altima without consent and used the credit card inside to make unauthorized purchases. The vehicle was later located by FRPD and the son was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle without Owner's Consent, Identity Theft, Bail Jumping and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was later transported to county jail.

**Retail Theft/Mutual Aid

On Monday, 04/11/22, at 1850 hours, FRPD Officers were dispatched to Walmart to assist Greenfield Police Department in locating a vehicle that was involved in a Retail Theft in their jurisdiction. Officers made contact with the suspect and discovered he had committed a theft at our Walmart as well, taking merchandise valued at \$1,077.30. The suspect was turned over to Greenfield PD with charges for our incident to be filed after further investigation.

**Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1st Offense
7700BLK S Lovers Lane Rd**

On Tuesday, 04/12/22, at 0119 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Operating A Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-1st Offense, and Causing Property Damage Adjacent to Highway – Hit and Run. The subject later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.23.

This occurred after Officers discovered a light pole at the roundabout on the 9700 Blk West Drexel Avenue had been struck, leaving parts of the suspects vehicle in the roadway. Officers located a vehicle in a nearby driveway that matched the damage and made contact with the driver at his residence. He was booked, cited, and released to a sober party.

Staff at the hotel contacted the Department about 2 packages that were sent to their hotel to a subject not staying there. Staff recognized the packages to likely be fraudulent purchases. Contact was made with the listed recipient of the packages who reported not making the purchases. They then discovered two unauthorized purchases on their bank statement.

On Thursday, 04/14/22, at 1655 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing, and for having valid warrants through Community Corrections for a Probation Violation and Fond du Lac County for Failure to Appear for a Theft case. Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense

He was booked, cited, and released to a sober party. His vehicle was towed from the scene.

On Sunday, 04/17/22, the Franklin Police Department assisted the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office with the investigation of the death of an 83 year old Franklin Resident.
