The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

Retail Theft 6919 S 27th St - GFS Martketplace

On Monday, 04/24/23, at 0932 hours, GFS reported two as-yet unidentified suspects left the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$267.31. They fled in a vehicle prior to Officer arrival.
