04/25/2022

Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated 10100 Blk S 92nd St

On Monday, April 25,22, at 0617 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated. This occurred after the subject was found walking in traffic, covered in blood, appearing to be under the influence of drugs. His vehicle was located off the roadway near S 92nd St and 8 Mile Rd, having been in a substantial crash. The subject was turned over to medical personnel at a nearby hospital after a Drug Recognition Expert evaluation.
