The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

Restraining Order Violation 10500 Blk W Cortez Cir

On Monday, 04/03/23, a resident reported that her ex-boyfriend violated the restraining order she had filed against him by messaging her on Google Meets. The case was sent to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office for an out of custody review for charging.
