04/04/2022

Disorderly Conduct - Domestic Violence 9300 Blk S Sherwood Dr

On Monday, 04/04/22, at 0927 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct – Domestic Violence related after he threatened his father with physical harm. The subject was later turned over to county jail. Charges were referred to the DA's office for review.

Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence, DV Repeat Offender, 72 Hour No Contact Order Violation, Resisting Arrest

Charges were referred to the DA's office for review.

OWI-3rd/OWI-causing injury/Recklessly Endangering Safety/Endangering Safety by Use of Dangerous Weapon 8400BLK W Ryan Rd

On Wednesday, 04/06/22, at 2235 hours, a subject out of West Bend was taken into custody for Operating While Intoxicated - Third Offense, OWI causing injury, Recklessly Endangering Safety and Endangering Safety by Use of Dangerous Weapon (Armed While Intoxicated). This occurred after the subject crossed the center line of the roadway and struck another vehicle occupied by three children and one adult. All were transported to a local hospital where they were treated for injuries sustained from the crash. The subject was armed with a firearm at the time of the crash. Field sobriety testing was conducted and revealed the subject was intoxicated. He was later turned over to county jail.

The caller was advised to delete his social media accounts and to not share sensitive material with strangers on the internet.
