Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

08/01/2022

Theft 9000 Blk W Elm Ct

On Monday, 08/01/22, a victim reported that between 1530 hours on 07/31/2022 and 0645 hours on 08/01/2022, unknown actor(s) entered his vehicle and removed his check book without his consent.

Disorderly Conduct
