# Here is a list of notable events from the last week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **08/15/2022**

### **Death Investigation 7500 Blk S 68th St**

On Monday, 08/15/22, at 0753 hours, FRPD assisted the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office with the investigation of the death of a 59 year old Franklin resident.

### **Fraud 7900 Blk S 68th St**

On Monday, 08/15/22, a resident of Franklin was contacted by an unknown individual claiming to be with the Federal Government. The victim was offered \$100,000.00 in grant money if she provided bank and debit card information. The unknown individual then utilized this information to make several unauthorized purchases.
