# Here is a list of notable events from the last week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **08/22/2022**

### **Threats to Law Enforcement/Resisting Arrest/Battery-Domestic Violence/ False Imprisonment/ Strangulation/Violation of Parole/Criminal Damage to Property 8361 S 27th St – Skyway Motel**

On Monday, 08/22/22, at 0112 hours, at the Skyway Motel, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Threats to Law Enforcement, Domestic Violence - Battery, Disorderly Conduct, Resisting Arrest, Criminal Damage to Property and Violation of Parole. This occurred after he caused a disturbance at the motel, damaged property, and battered his pregnant girlfriend. He resisted arrest and made threats to the arresting Officers. He was turned over to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility. Charges were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

### **Warrant Arrest 6715 S 27th St- Wendy's Old Fashioned Hamburgers**

On Monday, 08/22/22, at approximately 1345 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with the Department of Corrections for Parole Violation. This occurred at Pick N Save when he repeatedly exposed his genitals to a store employee. He was booked, cited, and released after posting bail. Charges were referred to the DA's Office.

**Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-1<sup>st</sup> Offense

On Monday, 08/22/22, at approximately 1836 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 1st Offense. This occurred after a witness reported observing the subject's vehicle swerving out of its lane and nearly striking the caller. He later provided and evidentiary breath sample that indicated he had a prohibited alcohol concentration of .23. He was booked, cited, and released to a sober party.
