Traffic Crash

S Franklin Dr / W Ryan Rd - 1559 hours

Officers responded to a 2-vehicle crash. 1 vehicle was towed due to damage.

Fraud

7130 S 76th St – Walgreens – 1414 hours

A resident reported she had been contacted by someone claiming to be from Publisher's Clearing House who advised her to provide several hundred dollars in gift card codes over the phone to be entered into a drawing for \$10,000 per month for life. She had purchased the gift cards but was advised this was a scam by another customer.
