The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

Rescue

10741 S 27th St – On the Border

On Monday, 08/29/22, at 0142 hours, officers were dispatched to On The Border after receiving a report of a male subject unconscious in parking lot. Upon arrival, Officers determined the subject was experiencing an apparent narcotic overdose and administered two doses of Narcan and performed life saving measures. He was turned over to FFD and transported to an area hospital.
